Attendance

School doors open at 8.50am and the school playground gate will close at 9am, please ensure children arrive on time. If they arrive late they will need to be brought round to the visitor entrance so the school office can mark them in.

At school pick Key stage 1 children finish at 3pm and Key stage 2 children finish at 3.10pm.
