Maths

In Maths we will be focusing on:

123

- Finding and matching objects that are the same.
- Sorting objects into a range of attributes such as colour, shape or size.
- Comparing and ordering sets.
- Identifying sets that have more, fewer or are the same.
- Using mathematical language to describe the size of objects.
- Copy, continue and creating repeating patterns.
- Identifying representations of 1, 2 and 3.
- Subitising and counting objects reliably to 3.
- Mark making to represent 1, 2 and 3.

English:

In English we will be focusing on:

- Retelling familiar stories using own words and recently introduced vocabulary.
- Recognising the sounds s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, e, u, r, h, b, f and l.
- Recognising the tricky words is and the.
- Blending sounds together to read words using the taught sounds.
- Writing names.



Understanding of the World

This half term we will be covering the following topics:

- All about me!
- My family and Myself
- Where I Live
- People Who Help Us
- Our Community Through the Year



Expressive Arts and Design:

In Expressive Arts and Design we will be focusing on:

- Exploring sound in Music using our bodies and instruments.
- Mixing secondary colours.
- Creating self-portraits.



PE:

We have PE sessions on Wednesdays. Please make sure that both indoor and outdoor kits are in school on these days.

In PE we will be focusing on:

- Developing pupils ability to move in a variety of ways.

PSHCE & RE:

In PSED we will be focusing on:

- Our school rules; how we all help to make our classroom a happy place to learn.
- My feelings; words I can use to describe how I am feeling.
- What can I do when I am angry or upset.

Class messages:
