Robinwood 2022

I would like to give you an update on the Robinwood residential that is scheduled for next week. As a result of the national bank holiday, announced for Monday 19th September, I have been liaising with Robinwood regarding the options that are available to us. I have looked into various possibilities, including rescheduling for another date. However, Robinwood is fully booked for the academic year leaving no opportunity for us to change dates. Myself and the staff team are keen for the children not to miss out on this experience and therefore we have made the decision to go ahead with the residential but this will be for **one night**, instead of the original two nights that were planned. The one-night stay will still allow the children the opportunity to take part in the many activities over the 2 days and have the experience of staying away from home. In order to maximise the number of activities that the children can take part in on Tuesday, we ask that families drop their child off at school at **7.30am**, so that we can leave promptly at **8.00am**. The reduce in the number of nights stay will mean that parents will be due a part refund and we will communicate more information regarding this in due course.

We would like to invite to an information session on **Thursday 15th September** where more information will be provided. In the meantime, Mr Baker will be adding key information onto Seesaw in advance of the session on Thursday.
