Maths	English:
 In Maths we will be focusing on: Identify, describe and sort circles, triangles, squares and rectangles. Under stand and use positional language such as in, on, under, behind, in front and in between. Comparing and ordering sets. Identifying representations of 4 and 5. Subitising and counting objects reliably to 5. Mark making to represent 4 and 5. Find one more and one less that 4 and 5. Know the difference between day and night. Sequence events. 	 In English we will be focusing on: Retelling familiar stories using own words and recently introduced vocabulary. Recognising the sounds ss, ll, ff, v, w, x, y, z, qu, ch, sh, th, ng, nk Recognising the tricky words as, and, has, his, her, go, no, to. Into, she, he, of, we, me and be. Blending sounds together to read words using the taught sounds. Segment the sounds in words to write.
 Understanding of the World This half term we will be focusing on the topic of Transport. The children will: Name and describe types of transport. Be aware of safety when we travel around. Know there are different types of transport around the world. Know that transport in the past was different from today. Know that Ernest Shackleton travelled to Antarctica and travelling to cold places 	 Expressive Arts and Design: In Expressive Arts and Design we will be focusing on: Exploring music from different celebrations. Exploring how colours can represent different seasons. Pissarro's season paintings. Design and create a boat. Cutting a range of shapes with scissors.
 PE: We have PE sessions on Wednesdays. Please make sure that both indoor and outdoor kits are in school on these days. In PE we will be focusing on: Develop movements of running, jumping, stopping, throwing and catching. 	 PSHCE & RE: In PSED we will be focusing on: Teamwork and sharing; working together and waiting to take turns. How can I help my friends?
