Maths:

In Maths, the children will be answering fluency, problem solving and reasoning questions based fractions, decimals, time and money.



Art:

In Art, the children will create Architecture by designing, making and painting a relief tile and a mosaic.



Science:

The children are going to learn about rocks. They will learn about the three types of rocks as well as understand that some rocks let water through but others do not.



Geography/History:

Over the next term, the children in History continue looking at 'Law and Power'.

In Geography, the children will learn about Western Europe.



English:

Over the half term, the children will be producing work based on the story 'The Iron Man'.



Computing:

Computing will be taught in a full day block. The children will further code with Scratch.

French:

In French, the children will say some fruits and vegetables in French.


PE:
