This half term, the children will have lots of exciting learning opportunities including a trip to Nell Bank.

Maths:

In maths, we will be focusing on money, time, shape and statistics. If you can offer opportunities for your children to handle coins when you are out shopping or ask them to tell you the time, these will all help to consolidate their learning in school.

History:

As historians we will be exploring the 'War of the Roses'. We will look at how the civil war began and why and how it shaped history.

Geography:

Our geography topic will be on Asia, focusing on India and China. We will be looking at physical and human geography in these countries.

PE:

Our PE lessons, this half term we will focus on our fitness lessons where Mr Smith will take the children through their paces. We will be working on sending and receiving. Please can we make sure the children have their PE kits for Tuesdays and Thursdays. Forest school will also be continuing on a Tuesday afternoon.

DT:

This term, the children will be trying out their sewing skills by creating a book cover with a fastening.

Art

We will be looking at modern architecture, they will be sketching and recreating key buildings.

English:

This half term we will be focusing on the book 'Journey' by Aaron Becker. The book has beautiful illustrations. We will be creating newspaper articles, setting descriptions, character descriptions and working on generating and punctuating speech.

Computing:

In computing we will be looking at algorithms and what they are used for.

PSHE:

In PSHE the children will be focusing on transition. We will be looking at what transition means and how we can prepare ourselves.

Science:

The children will be exploring magnets and forces. We will be identifying magnetic materials and exploring friction and the affect it has on moving objects. We will be working like scientists and completing lots of investigations.

Music:

In music, the children will focus on Calypso music. They will be composing and performing their own piece in the style of a calypso.
