Dear Parents / Carers,

I am delighted to welcome you all to a new school year at West Vale Academy! Welcome, particularly, to our new families joining our great community. During our INSET training day yesterday, I thanked all staff for their hard work over the summer holidays. West Vale looks fantastic - classrooms are purposeful, calm and inviting, as are displays around school, and the atmosphere today has been great. - 2. Continuing to develop our Maths curriculum, by following a consistent approach to Maths lessons through school.
- 3. Further embedding our curriculum with a particular focus on Music, Art and D&T, including developing children's memories to recall knowledge and understanding across a range of different subjects and units

Due to the success of our parent showcases last year, we will continue to welcome families into school for class showcases over the year for children to share their learning with their nearest and dearest and these dates will be sent out on a parent event overview for the year. Furthermore, we will be opening our doors on Thursday 7th September from 3.20pm - 4.00pm for parents to drop in during these times to meet their child's new teacher and see their new classroom. We would love to see as many of you as possible during these times. We will also continue to share West Vale news and updates on Seesaw and our Facebook page, sending out our weekly update and also our end-of-term newsletters.
