Year 1


The children learning number bonds to 20 and 50. They will understand how to partition 2 digit numbers. They will represent these numbers using a variety of ways using concrete resources. They will then use these numbers to answer number calculations

Year 2 Money and multiplication and division

The children will start to learn about money. They will understand what each coin and note it worth and complete number calculation, reasoning and problem a solving questions.
