Maths:

In maths, Y4 will be focusing on Fractions looking at ordering decimals, time and money.

Y5 will be looking at angles and how to work out missing angles. They will also be exploring translation and symmetry.

English:

This half term we will be focusing on the book 'The Last Bear' by Hannah Gold. The children will be creating a balanced argument and writing a persuasive letter.

The children will be focusing on use of apostrophes and paragraphing in their SPAG lessons.

PE:

In PE this term, we will be focusing on Physical unit. This will include co-ordination and movements within different sports and activities.

DT:

This half term, the children will be using micro bits to create their own mindfulness timers.

Art

This half term we will be looking at Byzantine monuments and creating our own self portrait mosaics.

Music: In music we are looking at music from India.

Science:

The children will be exploring all about the water cycle.

They will be looking at the three states of matter and exploring what happens when condensation and evaporation occurs. It would be useful to discuss these in daily life as you observe them e.g steam in the bathroom, steam from the kettle etc.

History:

This half term we will be learning about The Stuarts. The children will be looking at the different monarchs and key events during this period.

Geography:

The children will be looking at South West England. The children will be exploring key human and physical geography including the river Thames and Canterbury.

Computing:

This half term we are continuing our exciting progress of the Mars Rover. We will complete some data transfers.

PSHE:

This half term in PSHE the children will be looking at Safety and the Changing Body. This will include internet safety topics as well as us being able to help someone in need of help!
